

#### Dear Families, Guardians, and Educators,

Whether you are a family member creating your own Quill classroom for the summer, or an educator looking for ways to help their students prevent the summer slide, Quill provides students with high-quality and content-rich activities that can help them become stronger writers.

The summer is a time many students relax, but also gear up for the following academic school year. We suggest keeping summer work simple with these easy-to-implement ideas:

- **Create a Summer Classroom**: A teacher, program counselor, or family member can create a class on Quill for any number of students to join. When the summer is over, you can archive this class.
- **Choose Your Summer Path:** Students can either be assigned a diagnostic at the start of the summer and then be assigned recommendations or you may assign students pre-made featured activity packs.
- Assign a Few Packs at a Time: Quill has over 600 activities, and many pre-made activity packs. To prevent students from becoming overwhelmed, we recommend assigning no more than 1-2 packs at a time.
- **Use our "Go for Green Quill Bingo" sheet.** This is a great way to incentivize completion and mastery of concepts assigned. Students can write in what they are working on and you can determine the prize!
- **Embed Concepts into Written Work.** If a student has been assigned any written work for the summer, encourage them to try new sentence types or incorporate skills practiced on Quill into their writing.



## Path 1: Diagnostic & Recommendations

Quill offers five different diagnostic tools to help you determine what your students' writing needs are:


- Starter Diagnostic (we suggest starting most students here, regardless of grade level)
- Intermediate Diagnostic
- Advanced Diagnostic
- Starter ELL Diagnostic
- ELL Diagnostic

Once a student has completed their assigned diagnostic, you will have the ability to assign them personalized recommendations based off of their individual performance on their diagnostic activity. These personalized activities provide up to 6-8 weeks of instruction for students doing on average 3-5 activities a week.

To assign the diagnostic from the teacher dashboard page, select "Assign Activities," "Explore Activities," "Assess student writing with a diagnostic," and select the diagnostic of your choice.
