

ICEP 産油ガス国招聘国際ビジネスセミナー —ブラジル連邦共和国— 開催案内

近年、脱炭素運動の加速化、再生エネルギーの急増などが見られる中、エネルギー供給の太宗は、まだまだ石油・天然ガスであり、今後の社会経済活動を維持、発展させていくためにはエネルギー資源の安定供給確保が不可欠であり、そのためには、様々なビジネスリスクを勘案したうえで、大きな埋蔵量が期待できる国、地域での権益獲得が重要と考えられます。

弊財団では、世界各地の国際入札動向及び探鉱開発状況を俯瞰しつつ、本邦石油開発企業等に対し、関心国、地域等をヒアリングし、毎年1から2か国を招聘対象国として選定し、関係政府、国営石油ガス会社及びエネルギー関係機関の専門家を日本に招聘し、当該国のエネルギー政策、資源開発動向、国際入札動向、国際入札システムの詳細、技術的ポテンシャル等を紹介するとともに、必要に応じ、講演者とわが国の関係機関、企業等との個別面談等を設定することで、本邦石油開発企業等による当該国での上流事業への新規参入に資することとしており、1997年からこれまで延べ31回にわたって国際セミナーを開催してきました。

かかる活動の一環として、弊財団では、一昨年より在日ブラジル連邦共和国大使館等と連携し、南米ブラジル連邦共和国からの招聘セミナーの実現可能性を追求してきました。

南米ブラジル連邦共和国は、一昨年の大統領選挙により、政治経済的には大きな変革を迎え、また、近年進められてきた海洋鉱区入札による探鉱成果が明らかとなりつつあることから、今後、再開される国際入札、特に **Pre-salt** を対象とした国際入札に世界の関心が集まっています。また、その巨大な埋蔵量ポテンシャルから、本邦石油開発企業及び関連産業等においても関心が高まっており、今後の国際入札への参加可能性を検討していくうえで、良いタイミングと考え、ブラジル連邦共和国の専門家を招聘し、同国の新たなエネルギー政策、国際入札の実施状況、参加条件（特に条件見直し）、探鉱開発活動の実施状況、既往の探鉱開発活動から得られた技術的、プロジェクトマネージメント的な面からの **Lesson & learn** 等を直接関係者からヒアリングする機会を設けることとしました。

Deputy Secretary for Oil, Gas and Biofuels of the Ministry of Mines and Energy



Mr. João José de Nora Souto is the Deputy Secretary for Oil, Gas and Biofuels at the Ministry of Mines and Energy of Brazil. Graduated in Geology at the Federal University of Bahia (UFBA), Mr. Souto also has a Master's Degree in Geophysics and is an expert in oil exploitation techniques. He has worked at Petrobras S.A. as a geophysics expert from 1987 to 1995 and has occupied several positions in the Ministry of Mines and Energy since 1996, including as advisor to the Vice-Minister and Director of the Oil and Gas Exploitation Policy Department.

3. Mr. Décio Oddone

Director General of Agencia Nacional do Petroleo (ANP)



Décio Fabricio Oddone da Costa has graduated in Electrical Engineering from the Federal University of Rio Grande do Sul and has studied Petroleum Engineering at Petrobras. He has attended the Advanced Management Program at the Harvard Business School and the Advanced Management Programme at the Insead. He was awarded an honorary PhD in Education from Universidad de Aquino, in Bolivia. He has worked at Petrobras and subsidiaries in Brazil, Angola, Libya, Bolivia (of which he was the CEO) and Argentina (of which he was CEO and Chairman of the Board of Directors). Indicated by Petrobras, he was the Vice-President of Braskem. He was also Chairman of the Board of Directors at Innova S.A. and Braskem-Idesa S.A.P.I, and Director of Oil and Gas Projects at Prumo Logística S.A. He was the President of the Bolivian-Brazilian Chamber of Commerce and the Argentine Chamber of the Oil Industry. Since 2016, he has been the Director-General of the ANP.

ANP – Brazilian Agency for Petroleum, Natural Gas and Biofuels

The Brazilian Agency for Petroleum, Natural Gas and Biofuels is the regulation authority for the activities within the oil, natural gas and biofuels industry in Brazil. The federal agency, which reports to the Ministry of Mines and Energy, runs the national policy for the sector, focusing on the assurance of fuel supply and the

interests of consumers.

From well to wheel: the Agency regulates more than 130 thousand companies, from oil and gas exploration and production in the Brazilian sedimentary basins to the procedures to guarantee the quality of fuels distributed to the final consumer. The ANP's objectives include: to establish the regulations for the operation of oil, gas and biofuels companies, to promote bidding rounds for exploration and production of oil and natural gas and to inspect the activities performed by regulated industries in Brazil.

4. Mr. Roberto Furian Ardenghy

Chief Institutional Relations Executive Officer of Petrobras



Roberto Ardenghy holds a B.A. in Law from the Federal University of Santa Maria and a master degree in International Relations and Diplomacy, from the Diplomatic Academy of Rio Branco Institute. He also did post-graduation studies in Economics of Oil and Gas at COPPE Federal University of Rio de Janeiro.

Along his professional diplomatic career, he held a number of senior positions in the Brazilian Government at the Presidency of the Republic, the Ministries of Foreign Affairs, Justice, Development, Industry and Trade, the Federal Administration Secretariat and the Brazilian Embassies in Washington and Buenos Aires.

From 2002 to 2007 he worked as Chief of Staff, President of the Ethics Committee and Head of Downstream at the National Petroleum Agency – ANP and from 2007 to 2011, he served as Corporate Relations Manager at BG E&P Brasil, a British based oil & gas operator. During this period, he was a member of the Upstream Committee of the Brazilian Petroleum Institute (IBP) and Director of the American Chamber of Commerce of Rio de Janeiro - AmCham Rio.

Roberto Ardenghy taught International Law at the Candido Mendes Law School in Rio de Janeiro and oil & gas regulation at the Brazilian Petroleum Institute and COPPE-Federal University of Rio de Janeiro.

He rejoined the Federal Government in 2012 and was transferred to Houston as Deputy Consul General and Head of the Department of Trade and Investments Promotion. He was also Honorary President of the Brazil-Texas Chamber of Commerce (BRATECC) and Deputy Consul General at the Brazilian Consulate General in New York from May 2017 to December 2018.

On January 2019 he was appointed Chief of Staff of the CEO Office at Petrobras and in May 2019 he became Institutional Relations executive board member at Petrobras with responsibilities to oversee Communication, Social Responsibility and Government Affairs
