



# 2021 "H" RIESLING

MOSEL, GERMANY



Dr. Hermann, the Riesling-Estate with more than 9.5 hectares of vineyards, is managed by Christian Hermann. Winegrowing has been a tradition in the Hermann family for several hundred years. The estate was created in 1967 when the renowned estate Joh. Jos. Christoffel Erben in Ürzig was divided. In the following years, the vineyards were expanded. The Hermann's specialize in Riesling grown on steep rock slopes. All of their vineyards grow exclusively on old, ungrafted Riesling vines which deliver the most complex Riesling wines.

## VITICULTURE/VINIFICATION

Riesling grapes are hand harvested from Erdener Herrenberg, Kinheimer Hubertuslay and Löslicher Försterlay vineyards at optimum ripeness. Vines are between 15 and 40-years-old. The must is fermented in stainless steel tanks. The wine is bottled young in order to retain its freshness, this vintage was bottled in February 2022.

## TASTING NOTES

"The 2021 "H" Riesling opens with a pure, bright and crunchy, slatey bouquet. Clear and juicy on the palate, this is a pure but round and delicious Riesling in the off-dry style. This is a mouth-filling Mosel classic with fine grip and stimulating salinity."
