





THINKING MONEY FOR KIDS PROGRAM KIT

In 2019, the American Library Association and FINRA developed a Thinking Money for Kids traveling exhibit focused on teaching financial literacy concepts to school age children through fun hands-on and interactive learning stations. This year, Middle Country Library Foundation will be receiving \$6,000 from ALA/FINRA for work provided by two MCPL staff members on their newest initiative, Thinking Money for Kids Program Kit. The goal of the new initiative is to create five boxed games for use in library programs focused on the same financial literacy concepts explored in the larger traveling exhibit. One staff member is serving as an advisor in the development and creation of the kits. The other staff member is working on pilot programming and training videos. These program kits and training materials will be distributed to 300 libraries nationwide, selected as Thinking Money for Kids Program Kit grant recipients. Middle Country Public Library is proud to work on this important project and to be one of the selected libraries.
