Claimant requests review of those portions of Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Otto's order that: (1) upheld the SAIF Corporation's denial of his left shoulder aggravation claim; (2) upheld SAIF's denial of his new/omitted medical condition claim for a consequential left shoulder arthritis condition; and (3) upheld SAIF's *de facto* denial of his new/omitted medical condition claim for left shoulder impingement and bursitis. On review, the issues are aggravation and compensability.

We adopt and affirm the ALJ's order.¹

ORDER

The ALJ's order dated December 21, 2011 is affirmed.

¹ With respect to claimant's new/omitted medical condition claim for "traumatic arthritis," in addition to the ALJ's reasoning concerning a "consequential condition," we find that the persuasive medical evidence (Exs. 40-7, -12, -15 through 17, 41-12, -13, -17 through 19) does not establish compensability under a material contributing cause standard. See ORS 656.005(7)(a); ORS 656.266(1); *Maureen Y. Graves*, 57 Van Natta 2380, 2381 (2005).
